Insane51 flips the script in 3D. The Greek muralist has pioneered the 'double exposure' technique to create murals that shift to reveals two worlds. Exploring the balance between fragility and renewal, this mural is inspired by a poem from Rochdale school children created as part of Wild Wonders 2024. Grab some 3D glasses and see it shift.

Cabasa's first mural is a shout from the soul. Led by Rhian Kempadoo-Millar, Lizzie Rigby and Emily Wood, it dives into Women's unheard stories around reproductive health. Inspired by voices from Rochdale's Soul Sisters, Seriously Crafty and beyond, it's bold, beautiful and rooted in lived experience. Pushing boundaries and visually stunning – this is art with heart.

LeiMai's wrapping Rochdale in colour. Scouse born, Manchester based and bold to the bone, Lei-Mai's murals fuse graffiti grit with playful design. Inspired by local flora and fauna, these wraps are wild, vibrant and full of life.

Onur

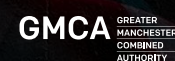
